DIGNITY AT WORK CHARTER

We at Youth Theatre Ireland commit ourselves to working together to maintain a workplace environment that encourages and supports the right to dignity at work. All who work here are expected to respect the right of each individual to dignity in their working life. All will be treated equally and respected for their individuality and diversity. Bullying in any form is not accepted by us and will not be tolerated. All individuals whether employed by us or contracted by us have a duty and a responsibility to uphold this dignity at work charter.

In addition, we ask all Contractors to adhere to our Code of Behaviour for Contractors:

- Professionalism: Conduct yourself with professionalism and integrity when working with Youth Theatre Ireland. Demonstrate respect, reliability, and accountability in all interactions.
- Respect for Youth Theatre Ireland staff, parents / guardians, and young people: Treat all staff, parents / guardians, and young people in a respectful manner.
- Compliance: Adhere to Youth Theatre Ireland's guidelines for all projects. Respect confidentiality and privacy requirements.
- Safety: Prioritize the safety and well-being of young people, staff, and participants. Follow health and safety guidelines and report any concerns or incidents promptly to Youth Theatre Ireland staff.
- Collaboration: Collaborate effectively with Youth Theatre Ireland staff with the delivery of all programmes.
- Partnership: Respect and adhere to any regulations and instructions from partner organisations such as venues or other institutions.
- Leadership: Demonstrate behaviours that are positive, inclusive and create a productive environment.
- Maintain open communication and work in alignment with the organization's mission, objectives and values.
- Enjoy your work and have fun.
